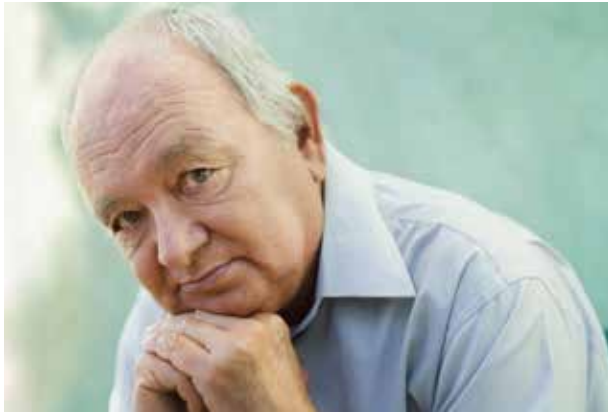


Program Information

You may be one of the 20,000 to 25,000 low-income older adults in Bucks County who are eligible for but not enrolled in these publicly funded benefits. If your 2016 gross annual income is lower than **\$23,760** (single person) or **\$32,404** (couple), you may be eligible for one or more of these benefits.

Enrollment improves economic stability. Financial stability lowers the risk of nursing home placement and increases opportunity for aging in place.

Services

We provide free public benefits counseling to low-income older adults.

Our Benefits Navigator can help you apply for:

- **SNAP** – also called Food Stamps
- **LIHEAP** – Heating Assistance
- **PACE/PACENet** – to help lower prescription costs
- **Extra Help/LIS** – also helps lower your prescription costs
- **Medicare Savings Benefit (MSB)** – the state will pay your Medicare Part B premium
- **Medical Assistance** – to provide comprehensive, low cost health care
- **Property Tax/Rent Rebate** – receive a refund of taxes or rent paid in the prior year
